## \*SELF-IDENTIFICATION DESCRIPTIONS

## Use the following classifications to identify yourself

#### RACE/ETHNIC:

- 1. BLACK (not of Hispanic origin): All persons having origins in any of the Black racial groups.
- 2. ASIAN or PACIFIC ISLANDERS: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This area includes Chins, Japan, Korea, the Philippine Islands, Samoa, and the Indian Subcontinent.
- 3. HISPANIC: All persons of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.
- 4. WHITE (not Hispanic origin): All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, North Africa and the Middle East.
- 5. AMERICAN INDIAN or ALASKAN NATIVE: Persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North America and maintaining cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition.

#### **VIETNAM-ERA VETERAN:**

If you served on active duty for the period beginning on February 28, 1961, and ending on May 7, 1975, in the case of a veteran who served in the Republic of Vietnam during that period; or the period beginning on August 5, 1964, and ending on May 7, 1975, in all other cases; and were discharged or released from that duty prior to December 31, 1991, with other than a dishonorable discharge.

## **DISABLED VETERAN:**

- 1. If you are entitled to disability compensation administered by the Veterans Administration for a disability rated at 30% or more, or
- 2. If you were released or discharged from active duty for a disability incurred or aggravated in the line of duty.

### **DISABLED:**

- 1. If you have an impairment (physical or mental) that substantially limits one or more of your major life activities. (A major life activity is any mental or physical function that, if impaired, creates a substantial barrier to employment.)
- 2. If you have a record of such an impairment as noted in #1 above.
- 3. If you are regarded as having such an impairment as noted in #1 above.
