- Tell your donor something about yourself.

Topics you may want to include:

- Your major or area of study
- Where did you go to school before LSSU?
- Is there a particular reason(s) you chose to attend LSSU?
- Have any of your life experiences significantly affected your life and your goals?
- How you are doing in classes or what is your favorite class?
- Your hometown, background about yourself, your family, and your interests
- Future career and education goals
- The difference this scholarship is making for you

- Please do not thank your benefactor for selecting you for the scholarship. Scholarship recipients are selected by the LSSU Financial Aid Office or recommended by a Selection Committee or Faculty, not by scholarship donors.
